As the most ethnically diverse county in the Southeast, DeKalb County is home to innovative industry leaders, highly respected colleges and universities, and exceptional workforce training programs -- all culminating to create an environment where businesses and residents prosper.

Starting as a farming community more than 200 years ago, DeKalb has grown to become Georgia's fourth-largest

county. Situated in Metro Atlanta, DeKalb today has four major interstates and is only minutes away from the world's busiest airport – Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport. The county ranks second in total labor force with proximity to more than 1.8 million people from surrounding counties. DeKalb County's strong economy and employment base continue to expand, driving growth throughout the region.

SPL^{OST}

Improving Transportation and Public Safety

DeKalb County in 2024 is winding up projects funded through a Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) that voters approved in 2017. This has been an additional one-penny sales tax

earmarked for roads, buildings, and major equipment. The projected SPLOST revenue through the end of the year is \$388 million. DeKalb's SPLOST is unique in that it exempts unprepared food and

prescription medication from the additional sales tax. Another six-year SPLOST was approved by voters in November 2023 and begins in April 2024.

Quality of Life Arts, Entertainment, and More!

DeKalb County's ethnic mix, one of the most diverse in the Southeast, is reflected in the immense variety of cultural offerings through our art centers, museums, theaters, and other attractions. With DeKalb residents speaking more than 60 languages, it's no wonder that global cultures are part of daily life here.

A sampling of the cultural assets in DeKalb County include:

- **ART Station** in historic Stone Mountain Village – This multi-disciplinary arts center is home to its own professional equity theatre company, five art galleries, a cabaret theatre presenting Atlanta's music legends, two gift shops, and space for arts classes.
- **Callanwolde Fine Arts Center** – Housed in a Gothic-Tudor style mansion built in 1920 by Coca-Cola heir Charles Howard Candler near Decatur, Callanwolde offers concerts, gallery exhibitions, and outreach programs in addition to classes in visual, literary, and performing arts.
- **Michael C. Carlos Museum** – This museum at Emory University in Decatur has the Southeast's largest collection of ancient art, with objects from ancient Egypt, Africa, Greece, Rome, the Near East, Asia, and Americas.
- **DeKalb History Center** – In the Old Courthouse in Decatur, the Center stages exhibits throughout the year, including 200 Years of

DeKalb County. The Center also maintains three antebellum structures in Decatur: Benjamin Swanton House, Biffle Cabin, and Barber Cabin.

- **Fernbank Museum of Natural History** – Explore ancient fossils, science interactives, and the largest dinosaurs ever discovered, all at this family friendly museum in Decatur where science, culture, and nature come alive.
- **Fernbank Science Center** – Explore our world and the universe itself at Fernbank Forest and the Fernbank Observatory in Decatur, which houses the largest telescope in the Southeast.
- **Marcus Jewish Community Center of Atlanta** – Theatre and art that reflect history and Jewish life are mainstays at MJCCA in Dunwoody, as well as fitness, wellness, and sports programs for members.
- **Oglethorpe University Museum of Art** – This museum in Brookhaven houses a collection of Japanese porcelain from the 17th to early 20th century, and nearly 700 drawings, prints, and paintings from 19th and 20th century France.
- **On Stage Atlanta** – This professional theater ensemble in Decatur has been producing compelling, relevant, and entertaining theatrical productions in Atlanta since 1971.
- **Porter Sanford III Performing Arts & Community Center** – Located in the historic Candler Road district of Decatur, this 500-seat

theater brings diverse programming to southern DeKalb County.

- **Rail Arts District (RAD)** – At the rail line where Avondale Estates meets Decatur, this collection of art studios and shops is a great place to find pottery making, glass blowing, paper arts, leather crafts, sewing and more.
- **Eddie's Attic** – This venue draws fans and artists from all over the world to Decatur and continues to be one of the premier music venues in the nation.

The DeKalb County Parks and Recreation Department offers activities for all ages and skill levels. Thousands participate in organized sports programs each year, including softball, baseball, cheerleading, basketball, soccer, and football. DeKalb County Parks and Recreation operates two public golf courses, Mystery Valley Golf Club in Lithonia and Sugar Creek Golf and Tennis Center in Atlanta, both of which are open year-round and seven days a week.

DeKalb County's municipalities work to serve all county residents with parks and trails within each city that are free and open to the public.

Other recreational assets in DeKalb are three branches of the Metro Atlanta YMCA – two in Decatur and one in Stone Mountain – which provide low-cost recreational programs to members.

- **Arabia Mountain Nature Preserve** in Lithonia and Stonecrest is a quiet preserve that is a great place to hike, bike, and explore the fantastic natural wonders of a granite monadnock.
- **Dunwoody Nature Center** in Dunwoody includes 22 acres of wetland, woodland, and streamside trails, display gardens, a picnic meadow, and a playground.

VIBRANT HISTORY, BREATHTAKING BEAUTY

Lulah Hills

Work, Live, Play

What was once the North DeKalb Mall in Decatur is now Lulah Hills. The new project is underway and is expected to be completed in 2025.

EDENS is the developer behind the evolution of the site. The 73-acre redevelopment will include 320,000 square feet for retail, 1,700 multifamily units, 100 townhomes, and a 150-room hotel. A trail will lead from the property to Emory University.

“Lulah Hills is the evolution of community. When it opened in 1965, North DeKalb Mall was a pioneering retail achievement, a one-stop shop for commerce and entertainment under one roof,” said Herbert Ames, Managing Director at EDENS. “With our redevelopment, we are designing a retail-focused, mixed-use destination that reflects the character of this community and inspires those who visit.”

“Lulah Hills will be intentionally convenient and casual – ideal for a relaxed family outing, the long-overdue date night or a morning cup of coffee,” Ames continued. “This place will once again enrich

community through innovative design, thoughtful curation and active engagement, just as it was known for almost 60 years ago.”

The name Lulah Hills is a play on an original naming concept by the renowned landscape architect Frederick Law Olmsted for the planned Druid Hills residential suburb. From its inception in the 1890s, the development of Druid Hills shaped the built environment of the majority of this region, from Atlanta and Decatur to modern-day North Druid Hills Road.

North DeKalb Mall was the area’s first fully enclosed mall. While it served the community well for decades, Lulah Hills brings new life and purpose to the site.

As a neighbor of Emory University, Lulah Hills will add to an already eclectic scene. Residents and tourists celebrate diversity and creativity, which makes the entire area exciting to explore.

EDENS CEO Jodie W. McLean said that the emotional, mental, and physical benefits of living in a place like Lulah Hills are hard to overstate. “Social connection and the quality of our relationships with others is a critical contributor to health, safety, and prosperity,” he said. The benefits of a development like Lulah Hills go far beyond the economic impact. It’s a new way for people to connect.

EDENS has developed spaces in 64 cities, across 17 states, including in Roswell, GA, north of Atlanta. Lulah Hills is its latest expression of how to make a lasting impression on the community as a whole.

Preparing for the Future

Life preparation starts in preschool, continuing through elementary/secondary school, career training, and higher education. Our workforce pipeline in DeKalb County is robust, and our programs are responsive to the needs of area employers.

DeKalb County School District

DeKalb County School District (DCSD) is Georgia's third-largest school system. Under the leadership of Superintendent Dr. Devon Q. Horton and the Board of Education, the District prepares students for college and careers through rigorous, relevant classroom instruction that speaks directly to each child's needs.

The District serves nearly 102,000 students, 140 schools and centers, and 15,500 employees, including 6,600 teachers. Students and parents speak more than 140 languages and represent more than 180 nations. DCSD is a leader in STEM curriculum with 10 certified schools and programs in more than 90 schools. With nearly 50 specialty schools, from magnet and International Baccalaureate (IB) to charter and Montessori, students and parents have many options when choosing a school.

The vision of the DeKalb County School District is to inspire our community of learners to achieve educational excellence. Their mission is to ensure

student success, leading to higher education, work, and life-long learning. This vision and mission are becoming a reality – every day, in every classroom throughout the District.

The District uses performance measures, targets, and initiatives to ensure success. A monitoring and data collection process was developed, and rigorous progress check procedures were implemented. Chamber of Commerce and Decide DeKalb, studying projections and work-related trends, promoting lifelong learning for high-demand occupations and building recruitment.

DeKalb County's Learn & Earn On-the-Job Training Initiative provides employers with a subsidy/reimbursement of up to 50% employee's wages for on-the-job training. The subsidy covers training costs for up to 90 days. Employers must agree to hire eligible individuals, provide them with skills training for a specific time period, and pay wages at the same rates as similarly situated employees.

Incumbent Worker Training (IWT) provides funding to train existing, full-time employees. This helps businesses to effectively retain employees and stay competitive, averting layoffs and possible business closings. Businesses may use public or private training providers, or approved in-house training providers, based on the type of training. Consequently, businesses gain a more skilled workforce, increase efficiency and pay higher wages for existing personnel.

Avondale Estates

Founded in 1924 by George Francis Willis, Avondale Estates is the only documented example of an early 20th-century planned garden city in the Southeast. After a trip to Stratford-upon-Avon in England, Willis was inspired to recreate the majesty of the Tudor-Revival style architecture in Georgia. Avondale Estates City Hall, along with main street buildings in the Tudor Village, remain examples of Willis' vision.

The city boasts a main street entrepreneurship mindset, including the home of the first Waffle House (opened in 1955). Its historic district is on the National Register of Historic Places. The city also includes an emerging downtown with a lively food, beer, and entertainment scene, and has been ranked #15 in the nation on Opendoor.com's Family Friendly Cities list for two years running.

Did you know? Voted the #1 Small Town Beer Scene by *USA Today* three years in a row, the city is home to three award-winning craft beer breweries and hosts the annual Avondale Ale Day in October.

What began as a home for members of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation and was transformed into Brookhaven Plantation in the 1800s transformed yet again at the turn of the 20th century when Atlanta residents began to build summer homes here, leading to the incorporation of Brookhaven Country Club in 1910. The small rail town known as Roswell Junction incorporated as Chamblee in 1908. The city originally was made up of dairy farms, railways, and Camp Gordon – a military operations site that served 40,000 military service members during WWI and WWII.

The next phase of Chamblee's identity was industrial, but as manufacturing and industry faded from the area, Chamblee's affordable home prices and proximity to Atlanta attracted refugees and immigrants who repopulated the city's neighborhoods and continued its growth.

Chamblee is home to the DeKalb Peachtree Airport and international cuisine.

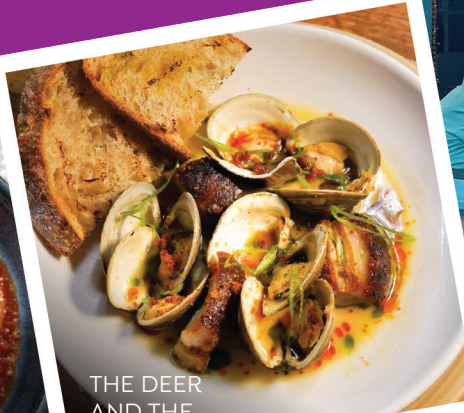

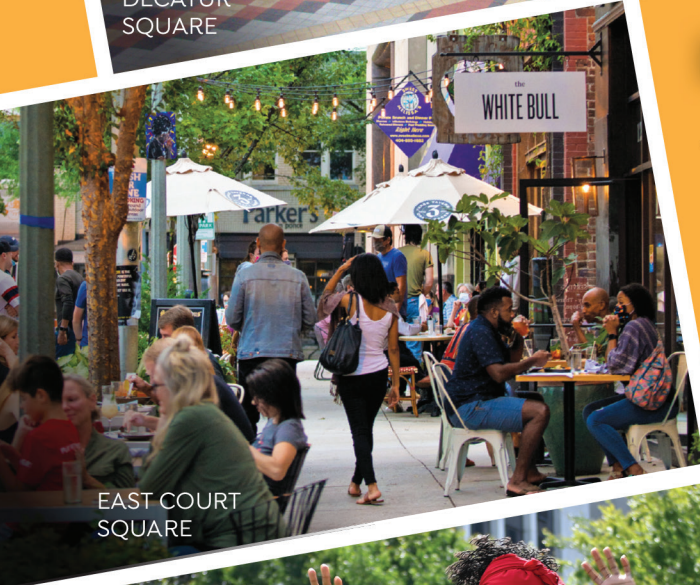

Doraville

Diversity, Vitality, Community

Doraville was founded in the 1830s and incorporated in 1871. Over time it evolved from a farming town to a railroad stop on one of the northbound lines out of Atlanta. During and following World War II, the construction of the Plantation Pipeline and the General Motors assembly plant changed the physical landscape and the future of the city. In 1990, the city became home to one of the last MARTA heavy rail stations, and currently serves as the end of the Gold Line for MARTA rail service.

Known for its diverse business community, international restaurants, and the former GM site, Doraville strives to be a welcoming, multicultural city. Today, the site of the former GM plant has been

repurposed as Assembly Doraville, a 137-acre mixed-use development. The first phase of the project, a 21-stage studio complex, opened for business in October 2023. Future phases are projected to add over 700 residential units, in addition to offices.

Community Events

Each September, the city participates in Welcoming Week, a national week-long initiative meant to affirm the importance of welcoming and inclusive places and connect residents of all stripes with their local governments.

In December, the city celebrates its Winter Holiday, a joyful event when residents and businesses come together to celebrate the diversity of its community with traditional multicultural dances, live music, entertainment, a small vendor's market, and memorable holiday pictures.

Dunwoody

A community engaged

Dunwoody incorporated in 2008 after experiencing unprecedented growth that inspired a three-year, citizen-led initiative to become an official city. Growth continues in Dunwoody where residents can experience urban amenities in a suburban setting.

Dunwoody was named for Charles Archibald Alexander Dunwoody (with just one "o"), the son of one of the founders of a nearby cotton mill. During the 1850s, the area had two cotton mills, which made it the largest cotton factory complex in North Georgia. A post office error added a second "o" to the name, and it's been Dunwoody ever since.

Great greenspaces are here, including the Dunwoody Nature Center and Brook Run Park.

Community Event

For more than 20 years, Dunwoody has hosted a five-day springtime festival called the Lemonade Days Festival. This annual event is designed to welcome new residents to Dunwoody and celebrate community. Families and friends come together to enjoy carnival rides, festive food and drink, stage performances, and the sweet and tangy drink itself – lemonade. Granite lives here

When rural farmers gathered for trade among themselves, Lithonia was born. Lithonia means "stone place," and the local granite has been quarried and used throughout the U.S. since the late 1800s. The introduction of the railway to the area in 1845 enabled Lithonia to become the epicenter of the regional granite industry. The architecture and historical structures of Lithonia placed the city on the National Register of Historic Places and tell the story of the area's development and relationships with granite and the railroad.

Amenities include the Lithonia Amphitheater and Lithonia Park.

In 1935, the Pine Woods Corporation began selling small lots around the lake as weekend retreats from Atlanta for \$69.95. The tents and trailers that once populated the lots over time made way for cabins. Next, two or three lots would be combined, and homes began to replace cabins. Soon, people started to reside in Pine Lake year-round and the city was incorporated in 1937.

In Pine Lake, residents and visitors from surrounding neighborhoods greet each other as

they walk around the lake and on the wetland paths. Public art is spread throughout the city and an Audubon Wildlife Sanctuary means art and nature intertwine in "Arts' Natural Habitat." Additionally, new commercial development is planned for the City's Rockbridge corridor that will provide an extra layer of city experience for residents and visitors alike.

Community Event

Second Saturdays at the Lounge is a musical event hosted – you guessed it – every second Saturday of the month by the Pine Lake Lounge at

the city's iconic beach house. Sponsored by the Municipal Arts Panel, the monthly jam includes jazz, blues, folk, and many other music performances from songwriters, solo musicians, and full bands. Stone Mountain was incorporated in 1839 as New Gibraltar. The village had a post office, a general store, a hotel, and an observation tower at the summit of the mountain. The name was officially changed to Stone Mountain in 1847. During the Civil War, Stone Mountain Village was destroyed during Sherman's March to the Sea. The railroad track is the oldest structure burned by Sherman to remain in use today.

Stone Mountain Park attracts tourists from around the world.

Community Attraction

Experience Stone Mountain's heritage by stopping in at the recently renovated Stone Mountain Depot Welcome Center, housed in the historic Train Depot at 922 Main Street. Just like the city, the Train Depot has an extensive history, with the south side being built in 1857 and the north in 1914. It served as the city hall and city jail from the early 1960s until 2012. Today, the building holds the Welcome Center, the Tourism office, and Downtown Development Authority office.

Assembly Atlanta

A hub for creativity and innovation

Assembly Atlanta is Atlanta's newest and most expansive studio complex. Universal Production Services and Gray Television are bringing this exciting project to life. Situated on 135 acres, the facility has 19 soundstages and 4 exterior filming locations. The outdoor locations have both a New York City and European vibe.

Support space, lighting, graphic design, and transportation make this a "one stop" for producing a movie or television show. In addition, costuming and fabrication shops mean everything can be produced here from beginning to end.

There is casual dining throughout the property, including green spaces in which to enjoy a meal.

Assembly Atlanta qualifies for tax incentives offered through the Georgia Department of Economic Development. A 20% transferable tax credit and a 10% Georgia Entertainment Promotion can be applied for by producers. Production and post-production expenditures made within the state enable filmmakers to tap into the program.

Developer Jay Gipson has been intimately involved in the project since the beginning. "I will never forget the first day we walked out here," Gipson said in an interview with Atlanta First News. "When my partner asked me if I thought we could do it, I said 'I think we can.'" The former General Motors site was sitting dormant, waiting for this kind of large-scale project.

"What is meaningful to me," said Doraville Mayor Joseph Geierman in an interview for *Site Selection Magazine*, "is that Gray Television and the Gipson Company saw the underlying value of the site, and invested in it in a way that will make it an even bigger job center than it was."

The Atlanta studio joins already existing facilities in Albuquerque, Los Angeles, and London. Doraville, 20 minutes north of downtown Atlanta, is homebase for the new studio.

A special aspect of the studio is public access. The studio will allow visitors to come in and stroll around the streets for an up-close experience of how films are made. Concerts and events will be staged in the studio's amphitheater to attract even

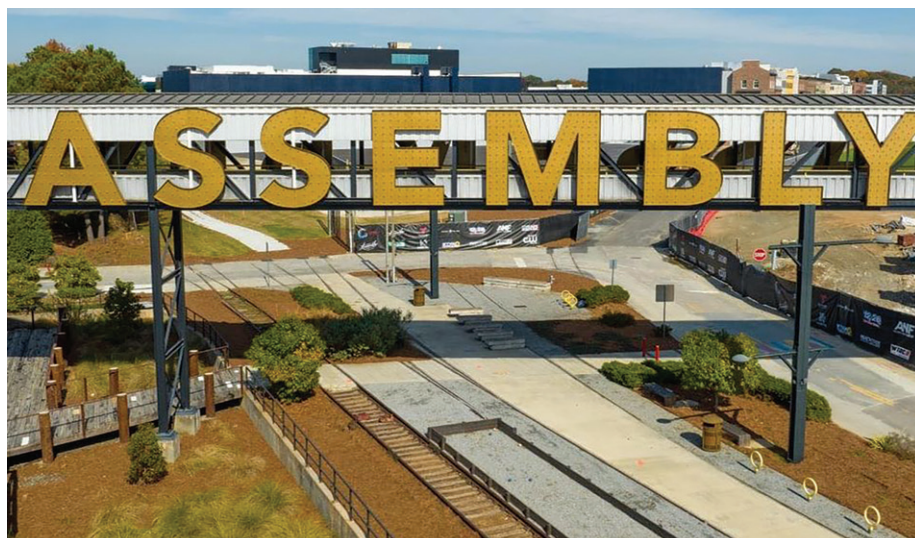
more visitors. Mayra Garcia, marketing manager for Assembly Atlanta calls this a passion project. "It is for Georgia by Georgia," she told Atlanta First News.

Gipson added in the Atlanta First News interview that "this is a monument for Georgia to show the world what Georgia can do."

The modern history of Hollywood coming to Georgia began in 1973 when Governor Jimmy Carter established the Georgia State Film Commission. Over the past 50 years the film industry has spent \$4 billion in the state.

With Assembly Atlanta's arrival, an already robust movie scene has gotten even bigger.

Years, and others. Third Rail Studios has 70,000 square feet of support space and 30,000 square feet of office space.

DeKalb County was one of 16 inaugural counties named Camera Ready Communities by the Georgia Film, Music, Digital and Television Entertainment Office in October 2010. Today, when crews are ready to shoot, DeKalb is set for action. *Halloween II*, *The Haunting of Hill House*, *Zombieland*, and *Venom* are just a few of the movies filmed here.
